

## Biography: Jill Attewell



Jill Attewell leads the Technology Enhanced Learning (TEL) Research Centre at the Learning and Skills Network (LSN). Research carried out by the TEL centre focuses on the use of ICTs to facilitate, enrich, enhance, support or improve access to teaching and learning, especially post-compulsory learning.

Jill's experience includes 13 years in education, mostly with LSN and its predecessor agencies, and 10 years in the IT industry working in the UK and the Far East.

A particular focus of the TEL centre's work for more than five years has been new and emerging technologies for learning including mobile phones and handheld computers, computer games and interactive digital television (iDTV).

From 2001 to 2004 Jill led m-learning the first large mobile learning project to be funded by the EU with partners in the UK, Italy and Sweden. She co-chaired MLEARN2003, hosted by LSN (then LSDA) in London, and MLEARN2004.
