### Tips for the Road

It is advisable to wear appropriate footwear and a hat. A packed lunch and water are also recommended. Parts of the walks include cliffs. A First Aider will always be present during the walk.



**West Part - Buskett Gardens / Dingli Cliffs / Fawwara / Lapsi / Hagar Qim Temples / Wied Iz-zurrieq (Blue Grotto)**



The excursion starts towards the heart of Buskett, adorned with numerous types of trees (including many Mediterranean) of all sizes and shapes. We then climb to a hilly plateau for a nice view over the whole area, Verdala Palace, and the entire view of Eastern Malta. We make our way to Clapham Junction and the garigue

of this area to explore some interesting scenery. The next part of the walk is a walk along the coast of Dingli Cliffs with panoramic views throughout the entire walk passing through Fawwara, down to Lapsi, through rocky paths towards Hagar Qim. We will stop here to visit the Temples and end up at Blue Grotto.
